

TWO THOUSAND YEARS AGO

A Crazy Miracle

One of these amazing miracles happened when Lazarus, one of Jesus's close friends, became sick. Lazarus had two sisters, Mary and Martha, who sent word to Jesus that he was very sick. They trusted that if Jesus was there, Lazarus would live. But even though He loved His friends, Jesus waited two days before He left to visit them. God's timing is perfect, even if it's not what we might be hoping for!

By the time Jesus arrived, Lazarus had already been dead for four days. Martha and Mary both told Jesus that they believed He could have healed their brother, and that Lazarus would live in heaven forever. But Jesus told them to open the tomb, and they would see God's glory. Then He shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" Lazarus walked out of the tomb, alive!

Death...

Jesus performed many other miracles, but it made the religious leaders of Israel afraid of Him. They worried that if their people believed in Jesus, their nation would fall apart, so they plotted to arrest and kill him.

They paid one of Jesus's friends to turn Him over to them. They arrested Jesus and nailed Him to a cross, even though He never did anything wrong. He died and was buried for three days.

& Life!

After three days in the tomb, Jesus came back to life! He beat death and sin so that someday, if we believe in Him, we can be made sinless and perfect and live forever with Him.

Do you believe that Jesus really died and came back to life? What does it take for you to believe in something you can't see?






KRYPTOS SCULPTURE

A detective has to interpret a lot of evidence, and sometimes that means cracking codes!

One of the most famous unsolved codes is called Kryptos, a sculpture by an artist named Jim Sanborn. The sculpture is on the grounds of the CIA headquarters in Virginia. It contains a code of 865 letters and 4 question marks.

Three of the messages have been decoded by several people, but it contains a riddle within a riddle that can only be solved when all four messages have been decoded. The mystery still waits to be solved!
