



OPERATION: CHALK ART

DEAR RECRUIT:

Here is a series of missions to measure your spy abilities. If you don't have chalk, we've given you suggestions for other items you can use instead.



MISSION 1: SPY SELF-PORTRAIT

This mission is easier to complete if you can recruit someone who lives with you to help. Lie on the ground and have someone trace the outline of your entire body with chalk. If you can't find another recruit, just do your best to draw the outline of your body. Then, color it in to look like you. If you don't have chalk, just use paper and crayons and draw and color a picture of yourself.

MISSION 2: LONG JUMP

Draw a cool and creative starting line on the sidewalk or driveway, or use a stick if you don't have chalk. Start behind the line and jump as far as you can (you may get a running start). Mark where you land with chalk. If you have a tape measure at home, measure how far you jumped. For extra fun, see who in your house can jump the farthest.





MISSION 3: TARGET PRACTICE

Draw a large target on the sidewalk or driveway, or use paper and crayons to draw it and place it there. Stand about 10 steps away from the target and toss ten rocks or sticks (or whatever you have handy) onto the target, trying to get as close as you can to the center. Count how many rocks or sticks you tossed that landed on the target.
