Christmas Eve is here, and Harvey and his friends have athered together to celebrate!


"But why do we celebrate Christmas?" Nutty wonders.


Harvey tells the amazing, true Christmas story.

Over two thousand years ago, in the land of Israel, a poor couple lived in a little town called Nazareth. Their names were Mary and Joseph, and they were engaged to be married.


During this time in Israel, a powerful country called Rome had taken over. The rulers of Rome did not treat the people of Israel kindly.

"That's right!" Harvey continued.






Sin keeps us from being with God. But God loves us so much, He had a plan to save us. All of this is part of God's wonderful plan.
