HEZEKIAH'S PRAYER

Hezekiah and his people were being threatened by a king named Sennacherib, from a nearby country called Assyria. Sennacherib and his army were getting ready to attack. They didn't think God could save His people, but Hezekiah knew He could!

- ➡ Read 2 Kings 19:15-19 in your Trailbook or Bible and fill in the missing words of Hezekiah's prayer to God.
- ➡ Find those words in the Word Search on the next page.

Verses 15 & 16: And Hezekiah prayed this prayer before the Lord: "O Lord, God of Israel, you are enthroned between the mighty cherubim (angels)! You alone are God of all the kingdoms of the earth. You alone created the heavens and the earth. Bend down, O Lord, and listen! Open your eyes, O Lord, and see! Listen to Sennacherib's words of defiance against the living God.

Verse 19: Now, O Lord our God, rescue us from his power; then all the kingdoms of the earth will know that you alone, O Lord, are God."
