

# A-GOOD NEIGHBOR


Jesus said, "Love your neighbor as yourself." When people asked Him how, and who our neighbor is, He told them a story.



Matthew 22:37-39 in your Trailbook says Jesus told the people, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself."

#### 1 John 4:12
