


OPERATION: SHADOW CHASING

DEAR RECRUIT:

You have been recruited to help with a special mission. There are shadows out there, and we need your help chasing them down!



TOOLS NEEDED FOR THIS MISSION:

- Sidewalk Chalk (in your spy kit)
- Crayons (in your spy kit)
- Paper, Preferably White
- A Sunny Day

MISSION 3:

Find the objects listed on the next page and trace the shadow that the sun creates! You can color in the object and be as creative as you want to be! For larger objects, simply use the chalk and your sidewalk or driveway. For smaller objects, position the white paper so the shadow is cast onto it and trace it with crayons.





SHADOW 1: Flower, small tree or bush

SHADOW 2: Bike, scooter or other outside toy

SHADDW 3: Toy - like a toy dinosaur or matchbox car or stuffed animal. Use the paper and crayons for these!

SHADDW 4: Action figure, doll or other small character. Try to position them in a funny way, like standing on their head! Use paper and crayons for this one, too.

SHADOW 5: Yourself! You'll probably need a partner to help you with this one! Have someone trace your shadow and then you can add whatever details you want!

EXTRA PRACTICE:

Find something that isn't listed and trace its shadow.
